White's cavalry company on June 14, On July 5, Forrest demonstrated that his personal sentiments on the issue of race now differed from those of the Klan Nathan Bedford Forrest he was invited to give a speech before the Independent Order of Pole-Bearers Association, a post-war organization of black Southerners advocating to improve the economic condition of blacks and to gain equal rights for all citizens.

June 10, Washington, DC: With slavery abolished after the war, Forrest suffered. Forrest was heavily engaged at the Battle of Shiloh in April and commanded rearguard actions during the Confederate retreat into Mississippi.
